Budget adjustment for 2018/2019 Season

- With the new Demosphere scheduling process East Central will need to pay to have the use of the scheduling tool. Cost is \$10.00 per team per season. East Central has a fall and spring season. Discussion was had as to the best way to handle the additional cost for obtaining the Demosphere tool. It was decided that the fee would be added onto the player fee we currently charge each player
- Registrars should be paid to process player pass cards. This player fee increase would also provide a way to pay the District Registrar and Assistant Registrars for processing player pass cards.

Demosphere

- Demosphere has offered to host the East Central Website. The cost would be lower than what we are currently paying, but there would be a fee to create the website and get it ready for our membership.
- Currently we are paying \$780.00 per month. Demosphere would change \$600.00. There would be a fee of \$1000.00 to do a custom makeover.
- A committee would work on the project to create the new website for the benefit of all members in East Central.
- Mobile friendly/Responsive website
- East Central will take money from other reserves that we have. This cost will not be passed onto the players.

East Central Scheduled Games – Spring 2018

The East Central Board has decided to cancel the first week of classic soccer games due to the unseasonable weather. All games scheduled for Sunday April 22 through April 27 will be cancelled and will not be officially rescheduled nor will scores for these games be included in the standings.

League games will resume starting April 28, 2018 for East Central Recreational, Academy and Classic Leagues. Academy events will be determined on an event by event schedule.

If the weather continues to make fields unplayable, games scheduled for April 29 through May5 may be moved by the home team to the week of June 24 for classic teams and July 15 for recreational teams. All games scheduled for April 28th or later are considered part of the schedule and will need to be played.

Clubs must notify their referee assignor of any schedule changes.

These scheduled movements apply only to East Central Scheduled events. State league games are not included in this adjustment.
