Instructions for Registering of Adult Players Register your adult players:

- You can use **any** of the following registration systems.
 - o *Demosphere Create a registration group.
 - WYSA will not bill you for these adult players.
 - You will pay normal Demosphere transaction fees.
 - Team Snap or any 3rd party app
 - o Paper application
- Players must sign waiver to play. See attachment waiver.

We hope streamlining the process will bring more clubs into participating, the hope is to see a two-tiered division sooner rather than later with young adults continuing their playing career in one division and old timers in another.

Team fees can be set by the club, but keep in mind:

- Referee fees
 - o Center \$64.00 Each team pays 1/2
 - o AR \$48.00 Each team pays 1 of the 2 AR's.
- East Central will bill your club \$25.00 for each adult player at the end of season.
 - o Covers insurance, scheduling, and administration.

Scheduling information:

- Monday May 6, 2024 Team application deadline
 - o Team name
 - o Team jersey color
 - o Coach and contact information: Cell phone and email address.
 - Field name and address
- Monday May 13, 2024 Schedule will be created and games clustered for referee assigning.
- Tuesday May 14, 2024 Schedule goes live. Sent to referee commissioner for scheduling.
- Tuesday May 28, 2024 Rosters are submitted to Executive Director.
- Sunday June 2, 2024 First week of games.
- All games will be scheduled for Sunday evenings.

Rosters:

- Clubs will fill in the team roster with one player per team.
- Players may be registered to one club in our East Central Soccer District.

Game Day

• The coach and/or team manager is responsible for paying the referees, presenting team roster, and insuring that the team is exhibiting sportsmanship at all times.

Rules for Adult League:

• Adult League players and clubs will follow all the East Central Soccer District rules.
